Regarding: **Scientific Calculators**

The mathematics curriculum incorporates technology in the teaching and learning of mathematical concepts and processes. To achieve this, Alberta Education requires all students in Math 10-3, 20-3 and 30-3 to have a scientific calculator. Alberta Education suggests a few different calculators, however, below are some suggestions for cost effective options that have all the necessary functions needed in math.

- Texas Instruments TI-30XIIS
- Casio FX-991ESPLUS2
- Casio FX-300EXPLUS2
- Sharp 272 Function 10-Digit 2 Line Display

The above list is not exhaustive, as there are many different options to choose from. However, it is important that whatever calculator your student chooses has the primary trigonometric function buttons (sin, cos, tan).

The school does not sell these calculators. You can look to buy new or used at places such as Walmart, Staples, Amazon, Costco, Dollarama, Kijiji, Ebay, or Facebook Marketplace. If you are unable to obtain a scientific calculator for your student's grade 10 class this year, please talk to your student's math teacher immediately for possible options.
